



- 1. Participation and Eligibility.** Participation is open to any artist 18 years of age or older unless a parent or legal guardian signature is obtained on the application form.
- 2. Artists.** Artists are defined as any individual or group who creates a product utilizing knowledge of design, drawing, music, painting, textile, etc. The Peninsula of Mobile reserves the right to determine appropriateness of art.
- 3. Pre-Registration.** A completed entry form, waiver, photographic sample of work to be displayed and entry fee must be received no later than close of business day Friday, April. Registration is a commitment to participate. No refunds.
- 4. Set-Up.** Exhibitors are responsible for set up requested at registration. Set up will begin at 7am, on the bay side of McNally Park pictured above. Tent sizes are 10' x 10'. The park can be quite windy this time of year. Special care should be taken to ensure safety of wares and tent(s). Tent weights are required.
- 5. Safety.** Safety First Security is providing security at the event. Each booth is provided with a printed list of names and phone numbers in case of emergency.
- 6. Electricity.** Electricity is not available. Generators and amplified music are not allowed.
- 7. Tear-Down.** The Bay's western shore can be quite windy during the afternoons. Extra care should be taken to ensure all trash/litter/debris is removed from premises.
