





ALABAMA 200 FOR 200

We invite artists to apply to participate in Alabama 200 for 200: Celebrating Those Who Shaped Alabama. Mobile Arts Council (MAC) wishes to celebrate those individuals and groups who have played a role in shaping the state of Alabama. MAC will do so through employing a group of artists (20 artists creating 10 works each) to visually depict these individuals and groups. Artists will be given minimum and maximum sizes for which they can create their works and all media forms are encouraged.

Artists will apply to be part of the project through an application process, during which time they will also suggest a few of their top subject choices (as a "wish list", from which the committee would have the final say). Those in the community will also be encouraged to submit individuals and groups throughout Alabama history for the committee's consideration.

Artists will be paid a commission of \$200 to cover the cost of supplies and materials. All commissioned pieces will be available for purchase online at www.mobilearts.org and in-person as the show travels around the state from September 2019 through March 2020 (or later, exact date TBD)

The final date for application is May 31, 2018. Notification of selection will be sent out starting July 1, 2018. Artists will be given their assignments of the 10 individuals or groups and payment of \$200 no later than August 1, 2018.

The first five pieces are due no later than December 15, 2018. MAC will begin releasing the names and images of the commissioned pieces starting in January 2019. The final five pieces are due no later than April 30, 2019. The exhibition will start at MAC in September-October 2019 and will then travel around the state.

How to apply:

- 1. Fill out the <u>online application</u> and submit up to three work samples. Submissions will not be taken via any other method. You can apply online at: https://webportalapp.com/webform/al200for200
- 2. Pay the application fee of \$10. Artists will be emailed an invoice after submission of their application. Artists will not be considered unless payment is received prior to the deadline.
- 3. Deadline to apply is May 31, 2018.
- 4. Submission of an application and payment of application fee does not guarantee a spot in the show
