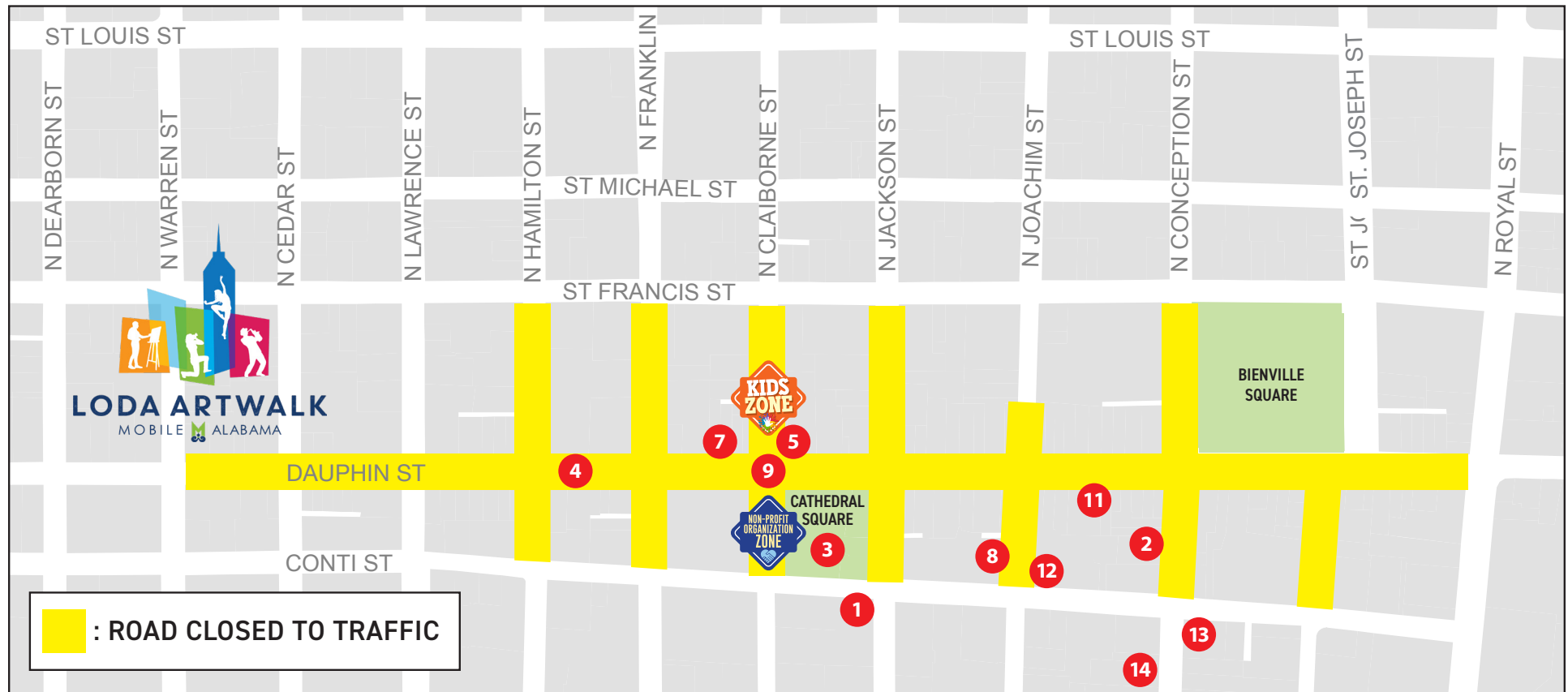


LODA ARTWALK INTERNATIONAL LEGO DAY: FRIDAY, JANUARY 13, 2023. 6-9PM

2. **Alabama Music Box:** 12 S. Conception St. Featuring the AMB Rock and Roll Flea, ArtWalk edition, with a Guest DJ spinning all vinyl. Come buy, sell, share or trade ANY and ALL things music related!
3. **Cathedral Square:** 300 Conti St. Featuring a showing of the Lego Movie starting at sundown.
4. **Dauphin Street Art Market:** 348 Dauphin St. Shop this outdoor art market featuring local arts and crafts vendors selling handmade, one-of-a-kind products on Dauphin Street alongside Cathedral Square.
5. **JPAR Gulf Coast:** 318 Dauphin St. JPAR will be opening their doors to display art work created by both adults and children of the community.

7. **Lupercalia Art Society:** 358 Dauphin St. Celebrating Recovery in January with a free BEAUTIFULLY BROKEN Class by local Artist Kari Ransom (Coastal Makers Studio) and with a Podcast by Dr. Susan Ferguson interviewing several Recovering Artists.
8. **Mobile Arts Council:** 6 S. Joachim St. Showcasing figurative works throughout the gallery, including “Body of Work” by Louis Tooker and “Friends & Figures” curated by Jessica Maples.
9. **Mobile Public Library** The Bookmobile will be on site for ArtWalk attendees to walk on the bus and check out books. Library cards can be issued on site, and there will be a variety of books related to Legos and engineering.

11. **Sophiella Gallery:** 111 Dauphin St. Featuring artist Ashley Terrell’s “Blurred Lines” as well as paintings, ceramics, sculpture by gallery artists. Don’t miss our upstairs exhibition space!
12. **The Haunted Book Shop:** 9 S. Joachim St. Join award-winning author Johnnie Bernard and retired police officer Mark Johnson as they sign their new thrillers, and come see Courtney Matthews’ lego-inspired decorations until 8 p.m.
13. **The Merry Widow:** 51 S. Conception St. The owner’s personal, large, Lego collection will be on display as well as Lego-themed art from various artists both local and national in addition to a Lego-themed cocktail menu, themed surprises and interactive displays! Plus vendors selling handmade crafts and food items.
14. **The Social Experiment:** 74 S. Conception St. Pop-up art gallery event featuring local artists and immersive experiences.
