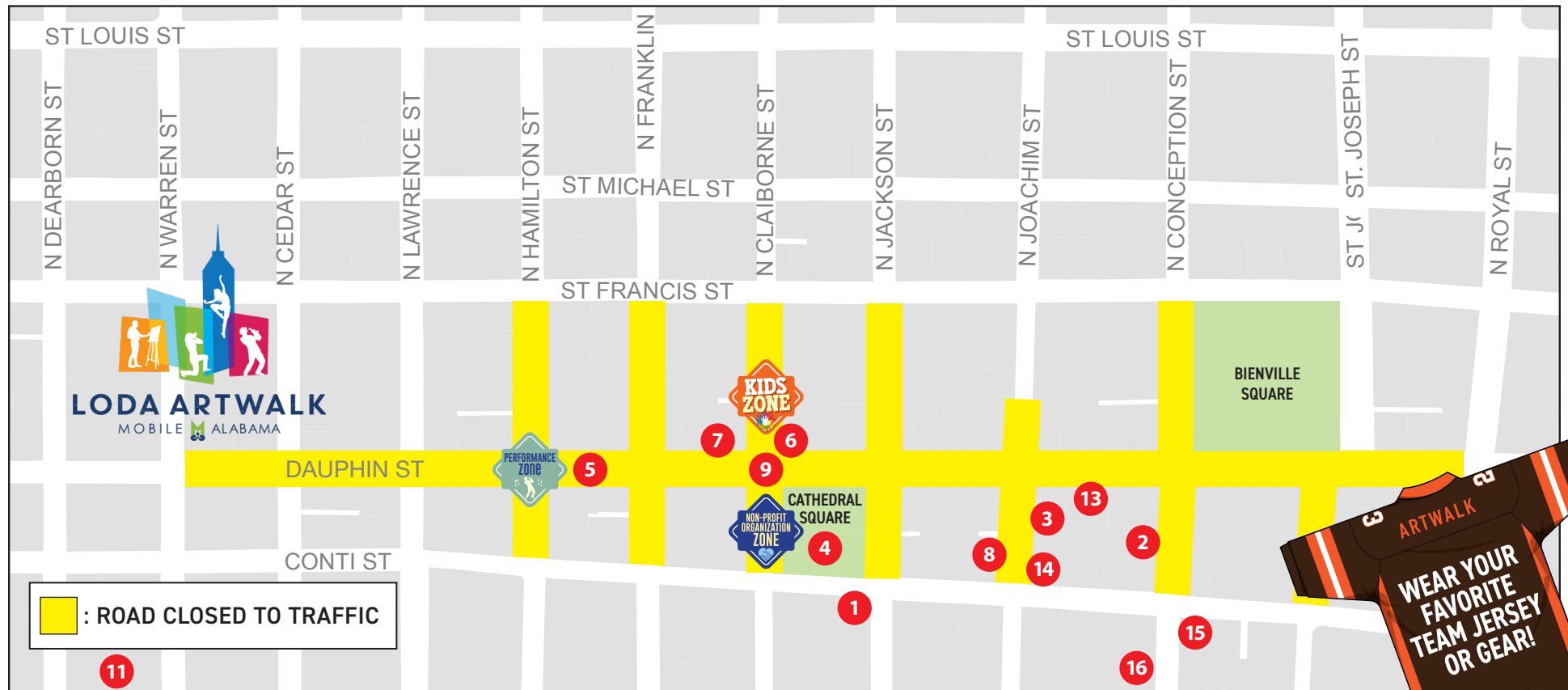


LODA ARTWALK CELEBRATES SPORTS ART & PHOTOGRAPHY: FRIDAY, MAR. 10, 6-9PM
